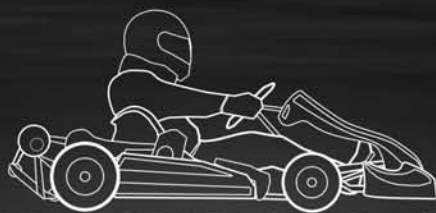

THE CHALLENGE

On Saturday 24th March 2012, Bentley Motors' Graduates will host the second Charity Karting Event, returning to the renowned Daytona Circuit in Milton Keynes.

Guests will experience a day of competitive racing in a 3-hour Le Mans-style endurance race, where teams can embrace the legendary racing spirit that defines Bentley and compete to become Bentley Karting Champions. Bespoke handcrafted trophies built at Bentley will be on offer for those on the podium and with the fastest lap.



In addition to racing, the event will deliver excellent hospitality with refreshments on arrival and a luxury barbeque lunch. There will also be a number of activities for those taking a break from the action on the track. Guests and family members are encouraged to come too, with juniors aged 5 - 15 having free, unlimited use of the junior track and the chance to win a trophy.

Bentley Pre-Owned is sponsoring the 2012 event and a number of Bentley cars will be on show for guests to view.

This is non-profit making event and all proceeds will be donated to the Prince's Trust, a charity whom the Event Team, a group of Bentley Graduates, have pledged to support through a number of fundraising activities.

The Event Team are accepting entries of teams with between 1 and 6 drivers at a cost of £1200 per team. Entry and payment is requested to be made by 24th November 2011 in order to confirm your team's participation. With a first come first served policy, secure your place as soon as possible to avoid disappointment.

9:00am	<p>Competitors & Guests Arrive</p> <p>Race registration opens & drivers begin to prepare for the event.</p> <p>Bentley products will be on display and light refreshments will be available throughout this period.</p>
10:00am	<p>Official Welcome & Briefing</p> <p>A formal introduction to the event will be given to all guests. There will also be full details of the race format as well as a safety briefing.</p> <p>Please note that all competitors are required to be present for the pre-race briefing.</p>
10:45am	<p>Prepare for Practice & Qualifying Session</p> <p>Teams will have the opportunity to learn the track and get themselves on the front row of the grid for the main race.</p> <p>The free Junior track opens.</p>
12:00pm	<p>3-hour Endurance Race begins</p> <p>The first driver from each team will be on the grid for the main event. Throughout the race there will be opportunities to change drivers in each team, a manoeuvre that can make all the difference!</p> <p>For all guests and those waiting for their stint in the kart, numerous attractions will be present at the circuit. This will be a great time for you to explore the other activities available as well as have a look around at a selection of Bentley Pre-Owned cars.</p>
12:30pm	<p>Buffet served</p> <p>A luxury barbeque buffet will be on offer for non-competitors and drivers taking a break from the action.</p>
3:00pm	<p>Chequered Flag & Warm-down</p> <p>Drivers change and prepare for prize-giving. Junior track closes.</p> <p>Prize-Giving</p> <p>The winning teams will be presented with their trophies as a mark of their achievement. The driver with the fastest lap and the fastest junior will also be presented with prizes.</p> <p>Closing statement and farewell to all guests.</p>

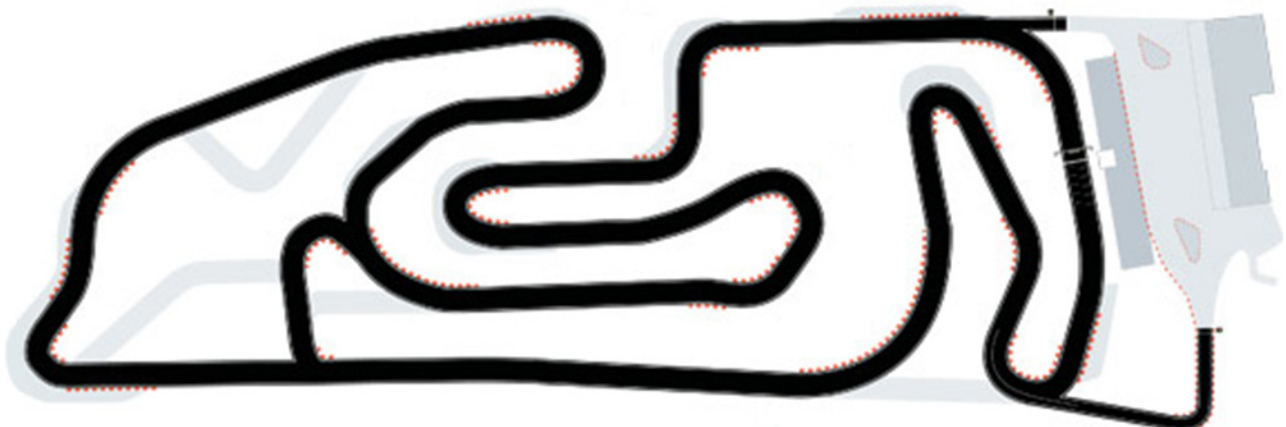

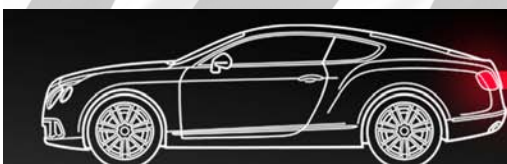
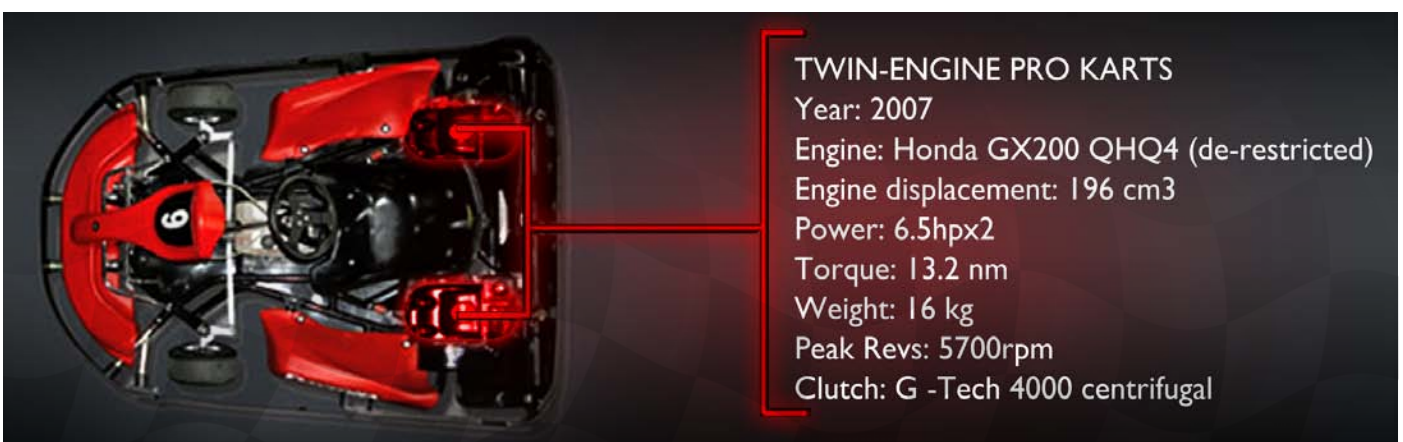
THE CIRCUIT

The Daytona International Circuit in Milton Keynes is widely regarded as one of the most exciting circuits in the UK and has hosted many great drivers including the likes of Lewis Hamilton (pictured), Jenson Button and Mark Webber to name a few.

This 1.36km adrenaline-filled racing track, combined with the twin-engined 60mph Pro-Karts, offers drivers an exciting and challenging day. With 11 corners, 1360m of asphalt and a lap record time of just 1 minute 8 seconds, there will also be plenty of opportunity for overtaking as drivers compete for the coveted prize. There is no doubt that every competitor will experience adrenaline filled action all the way to the chequered flag!

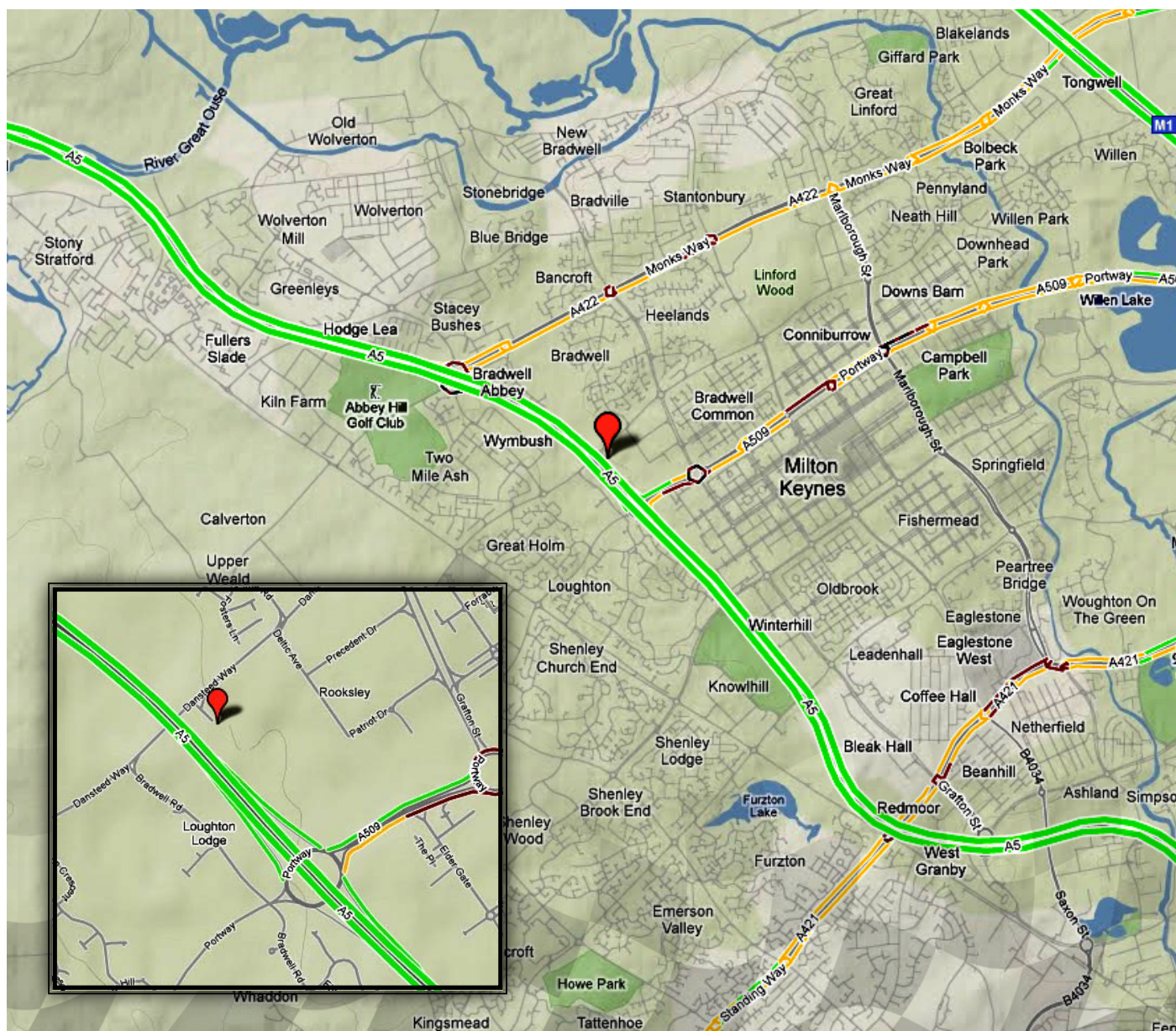
LOCATION

The circuit is located near the centre of Milton Keynes, just a few minutes from the M1 and makes the perfect location for those travelling from all across the UK.

From M1: Leave the M1 at Junction 14. Follow signs for Central Milton Keynes. At the first roundabout turn right onto the H5 Portway (A509). Continue along the H5 over 9 roundabouts until you reach the traffic lights at North Grafton roundabout (first set of traffic lights you will have come across) and take the third exit onto V6 Grafton Street. At the next roundabout turn left onto H4 Danstead Way. Daytona Milton Keynes is the second turning on the left.

From A5: Take exit for Central Milton Keynes (A509) Coming from the South turn right at the roundabout at the top of the slip way. Coming for the North turn left at the roundabout at the top of the slip way. At North Grafton roundabout (traffic lights) turn left onto V6 Grafton Street. At the next roundabout turn left onto H4 Danstead Way. Daytona Milton Keynes is the second turning on the left. Please keep an eye out for the Brown information signs with a chequered flag and follow to the circuit.

Please use postcode **MK13 8NP** if using satellite navigation.

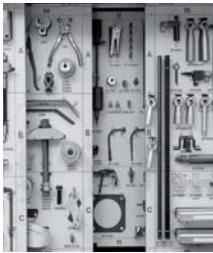

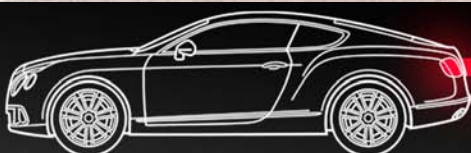
